David Konstan is Professor of Classics at New York University and has been a Professor of Classics at Brown University. Among his books are *Roman Comedy* (1983); *Sexual Symmetry: Love in the Ancient Novel and Related Genres* (1994); *Greek Comedy and Ideology* (1995); *Friendship in the Classical World* (1997); *Pity Transformed* (2001); *The Emotions of the Ancient Greeks: Studies in Aristotle and Classical Literature* (2006); *A Life Worthy of the Gods: The Materialist Psychology of Epicurus* (2008); *Before Forgiveness: The Origins of a Moral Idea* (2010), and, most recently, *Beauty: The Fortunes of an Ancient Greek Idea* (2014), published by Oxford University Press in the Onassis Series on Hellenic Culture. He is a past president of the American Philological Association, and a Fellow of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences and Honorary Fellow of the Australian Academy of the Humanities.
